13	1. That § 33.1-8 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and the Code of Virginia is
14	amended by adding in Article 10 of Chapter 2 of Title 2.2 a section numbered 2.2-229 as follows:
15	§ 2.2-229. Intermodal Office of the Secretary of Transportation.
16	There is hereby established the Intermodal Office of the Secretary of Transportation, consisting of a
17	director, appointed by the Commonwealth Transportation Board, and such additional transportation
18	professionals as the Secretary of Transportation shall determine. It shall be the duty of the director of
19	the office to advise the Secretary and the Commonwealth Transportation Board on intermodal issues.
20	§ 33.1-8. Employees; delegation of responsibilities.
21	The Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner shall employ an assistant commissioner for the
22	environment, transportation planning, and regulatory affairs, an assistant commissioner for project
