13 14	to the office of sheriff, police officer, marshal, or other peace officer, or who shall falsely assume or
15	pretend to be any such officer, shall be deemed is guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor 6 felony.
16	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
17	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is
18	\$117,330 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of
19	commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
