Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. § 1. *That pursuant to § 2.2-2264 of the Code of Virginia, the General Assembly hereby authorizes the Virginia Public Building Authority to undertake the construction, improvement, and furnishing of the following projects:*

116 *The amount authorized for each of the foregoing projects shall be reduced by any amount that is*
117 *specifically appropriated from the general fund by the General Assembly for such project.*

118 *§ 2. The Virginia Public Building Authority is also authorized to exercise any and all powers granted*
119 *to it by law in connection therewith, including the power to finance the cost thereof by the issuance of*
120 *revenue bonds not to exceed the principal amount set forth plus amounts needed to fund issuance costs,*
121 *reserve funds, interest prior to or during improvement and for up to one year after completion of the*
122 *improvement, and other financing expenses.*

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
