10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-29 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-29. Criminal solicitation; penalty.
13	Any person who commands, entreats, or otherwise attempts to persuade another person to commit a
14	felony other than murder, shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony. Any person age eighteen or older who
15	commands, entreats, or otherwise attempts to persuade another person under age eighteen to commit a
16	felony other than murder, shall be guilty of a Class 5 felony. Any person who commands, entreats, or
17	otherwise attempts to persuade another person to commit a murder is guilty of a felony punishable by
18	confinement in a state correctional facility for a term not less than five years or more than forty years.
19	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
20	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot

be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and \$0 for periods
of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
