11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 58.1-346.19 as follows:
13	§ 58.1-346.19. Voluntary contribution to the Virginia War Memorial Association.
14	A. For all taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2003, but before January 1, 2008, any
15	individual eligible to receive a tax refund pursuant to § 58.1-309 may designate at the time of filing his
16 17	return a specified dollar amount of such refund, not less than one dollar, to be used by the Virginia War Memorial Association in its work of establishing and supporting the war memorials throughout the
18	Commonwealth.
19	B. All money collected pursuant to subsection A shall be deposited into the state treasury. The Tax
20	Commissioner shall determine annually the total amount designated on all returns for the Virginia War
21	Memorial Association and shall report the same to the State Treasurer. The direct costs of
22	administration shall be deducted from such amount after which the State Treasurer shall pay the
23	remainder to the Virginia War Memorial Association.
