7	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 4 of Chapter 36 of Title 58.1 sections
8	numbered 58.1-3650.961 through 58.1-3650.989, relating to designating certain organizations to be
9	exempt from property taxation.
10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 4 of Chapter 36 of Title 58.1
12	sections numbered 58.1-3650.961 through 58.1-3650.989 as follows: § 58.1-3650.961. Property of Stafford Recreational Soccer League.
14	A. The Stafford Recreational Soccer League, a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a
15	public park and playground organization within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the
16	Constitution of Virginia.
17	B. Real and personal property located in Stafford County, owned by the Stafford Recreational Soccer
18	League and used by it exclusively for public park and playground purposes on a nonprofit basis as set
19	forth in subsection A, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
20	§ 58.1-3650.962. Property of Lake Ridge Community Swim Club, Inc.
21	A. Lake Ridge Community Swim Club, Inc., a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a
22	charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the
23 24	Constitution of Virginia. B. Real property located in Prince William County, owned by Lake Ridge Community Swim Club,
2 4 25	Inc., and used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth
2 6	in subsection A, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.

28	A. Running Man Recreation Association, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a
29	public park and playground within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the Constitution of

31	B. Real and personal property located in York County, owned by Running Man Recreation
32	Association, Inc., and used by it exclusively for public park and playground purposes on a nonprofit
33 34	basis as set forth in subsection A, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
34 35	§ 58.1-3650.964. Property of Gemeinschaft Home. A. Gemeinschaft Home, a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a charitable organization
36	within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
37	B. Real and personal property located in Rockingham County, owned by Gemeinschaft Home, and
38	used by it exclusively for charitable purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A, is hereby
39	determined to be exempt from local taxation.

41	A. STEPS, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable organization within the
42	context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
43 44	B. Real and personal property located in Lunenburg County, owned by STEPS, Inc., and used by it exclusively for charitable purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A, is hereby
45	determined to be exempt from local taxation.
46	§ 58.1-3650.966. Property of Winchester-Frederick County Conservation Club, Inc.
47	A. Winchester-Frederick County Conservation Club, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby
48	designated as a charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X
49	of the Constitution of Virginia.
50	B. Real property located in Frederick County in the Gainesville Magisterial District totaling 296.28
51	acres and identified as Frederick County Tax Map 29A, Lot 37B; Tax Map 29A, Lot 43B; Tax Map
52 52	19A, Lot 53A; Tax Map 19A, Lot 81A; Tax Map 19A, Lot 49; Tax Map 19A, Lot 52E; and Tax Map
53 54	29A, Lot 38, owned by Winchester-Frederick County Conservation Club, Inc. and used by it exclusively

58	benevolent organization within the context of Section $6(a)(6)$ of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
59	B. Real and personal property located in York County, owned by Caritas of Yorktown, Virginia, and

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60 used by it exclusively for charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. 61

A. Vienna Aquatic Club, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a public park and 63 playground within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia. B. Real and personal property located at 625 Marshall Road, S.W., in Fairfax County, owned by 64

65 66 Vienna Aquatic Club, Inc., and used by it exclusively for public park and playground purposes on a 67 nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.

149 County, owned by Arlington Foundation, Incorporated, and used by it exclusively for historical purposes

150 on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.

151 § 58.1-3650.981. Property of Mathews Maritime Foundation, Inc.

152 A. Mathews Maritime Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as an historical 153 organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.

154 B. Personal property located in Mathews County, owned by Mathews Maritime Foundation, Inc., and 155 used by it exclusively for historical purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A, is hereby 156 determined to be exempt from local taxation.

157 § 58.1-3650.982. Property of Marian Homes.

158 A. Marian Homes, a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable and benevolent 159 organization within the context of Section 6(a)(6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
