6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 8.9A-523 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 8.9A-523. Information from filing office; sale or license or records.

9 (a) Acknowledgment of filing written record. If a person that files a written record requests an  
10 acknowledgment of the filing, the filing office shall send to the person an image of the record showing  
11 the number assigned to the record pursuant to § 8.9A-519 (a) (1) and the date and time of the filing of  
12 the record. However, if the person furnishes a copy of the record to the filing office, the filing office  
13 may instead:

14 (1) note upon the copy the number assigned to the record pursuant to § 8.9A-519 (a) (1) and the date  
15 and time of the filing of the record; and

16 (2) send the copy to the person.

17 (b) Acknowledgment of filing other record. If a person files a record other than a written record, the  
18 filing office shall communicate to the person an acknowledgment that provides:

19 (1) the information in the record;

20 (2) the number assigned to the record pursuant to § 8.9A-519 (a) (1); and

21 (3) the date and time of the filing of the record.

22 (c) Communication of requested information. The filing office shall communicate or otherwise make  
23 available in a record the following information to any person that requests it:

24 (1) whether there is on file on a date and time specified by the filing office, but not a date earlier  
25 than six business days before the filing office receives the request, any financing statement that:

26 (A) designates a particular debtor or, if the request so states, designates a particular debtor at the  
27 address specified in the request;

28 (B) has not lapsed under § 8.9A-515 with respect to all secured parties of record; and

29 (C) if the request so states, has lapsed under § 8.9A-515 and a record of which is maintained by the  
30 filing office under § 8.9A-522 (a);

31 (2) the date and time of filing of each financing statement; and

32 (3) the information provided in each financing statement.

33 (d) Medium for communicating information. In complying with its duty under subsection (c), the  
34 filing office may communicate information in any medium *or, in the alternative, may provide the*  
35 *requestor with a list of persons that provide private record research services.* However, if requested, the  
36 filing office shall communicate information by issuing its written certificate.

37 (e) Timeliness of filing office performance. The filing office shall perform the acts required by  
38 subsections (a) through (d) at the time and in the manner prescribed by filing-office rule, but not later  
39 than five business days after the filing office receives the request.

40 (f) Public availability of records. At least weekly, the State Corporation Commission shall offer to  
41 sell or license to the public on a nonexclusive basis, in bulk, copies of all records filed in it under this  
42 part, in every medium from time to time available to the filing office.

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
