## **HOUSE BILL NO. 90**

House Amendments in [] — January 31, 2002

(Patrons Prior to Engrossment—Delegate Welch [HB 90] and Delegate Amundson [HB 754])

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 22.1-274.3, relating to certain medication recommendations by school personnel.

Referred to Committee on Education

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-274.3 as follows:

§ 22.1-274.3. Policies regarding medication recommendations by school personnel.

[Local school boards The Board of Education] shall develop and implement policies prohibiting school personnel from recommending the use of psychotropic medications for any student. Such policies shall not prohibit school health staff from recommending that a student be evaluated by an appropriate medical practitioner, or prohibit school personnel from consulting with such practitioner, with the written consent of the student's parent.

For the purposes of this section, "psychotropic medications" means those medications the prescribed intention of which is to alter mental activity or state, including, but not limited to, antipsychotic, antidepressant, and anxiolytic medication and behavior-altering medication.
