By September 1 of each year, the Supreme Court, or its designee, shall transmit a 14 report of the final evaluation of each justice and judge whose term expires during the next session of 15 the General Assembly to the Chairmen of the House and Senate Committees for Courts of Justice. 16 2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on July 1, 2003. 17 3. That the Supreme Court shall establish a one-year pilot program for judicial performance 18 evaluation beginning July 1, 2002.
