6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-423.01 as follows:**

8 *§ 18.2-423.01. Burning object on property of another or a highway or other public place with intent*
9 *to intimidate.*

10 *A. Any person who, with the intent of intimidating any person or group of persons, burns an object*
11 *on the private property of another without permission, is guilty of a Class 6 felony.*

12 *B. Any person who, with the intent of intimidating any person or group of persons, burns an object*
13 *on a highway or other public place in a manner having a direct tendency to place another person in*
14 *reasonable fear or apprehension of death or bodily injury is guilty of a Class 6 felony.*

15 **2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or**
16 **commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot**
17 **be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be**
18 **determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.**
