9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 8.01-294 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 8.01-294. Sheriff to get from clerk's office process and other papers; return of papers.
12	Every sheriff who attends a court shall, every day when the clerk's office is open for business, go to
13	such office and receive all process, and other papers to be served by him, and give receipts therefor,
14	unless he has received notice from a regular employee of the clerk's office that there are no such papers
15	requiring service and shall return all papers within [seventy-two hours five days seventy-two hours] of
16	service, except when such returns would be due on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. In such case,
17	the return is due on the next day following such Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.
18	Failure to make return of service of process within the time specified in this section shall not
19	invalidate any service of process or any judgment based thereon. In the event a late return prejudices a
20	[defendant party] or interferes with the court's administration of a case, the court may, in its

20 [defendant party] or interferes with the court's administration of a case, the court may, in its 21 discretion, continue the case, require additional or substitute service of process, or take such other 22 action or enter such order as the court deems appropriate under the circumstances.
