A BILL to amend and reenact § 24.2-105 of the Code of Virginia, relating to registration and elections forms and materials; language alternatives.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 24.2-105 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 24.2-105. Prescribing various forms and materials; language alternatives.

A. The State Board shall prescribe appropriate forms and records for the registration of voters, conduct of elections, and implementation of this title, which shall be used throughout the Commonwealth.

B. *The State Board may prescribe voting materials in a language other than English whenever the Commonwealth or any locality is required to provide voting materials in a language other than English pursuant to federal law, including 42 U.S.C. § 1973aa-1a and 42 USC § 1973b(f)(4). For the purposes of this subsection, "voting materials" means registration or voting notices, forms, instructions, assistance, or other materials or information relating to the electoral process, including ballots.*
