That § 46.2-725 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 12 § 46.2-725. Special license plates, generally. 13 A. No series of special license plates shall be created or issued by the Commissioner or the 14 Department except as authorized in this article. No special license plates in any series not provided for in this article and no registration decal for any such license plate shall be issued, reissued, or renewed 15 16 on or after July 1, 1995. However, subject to the limitations contained in subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of this section, the Commissioner may issue special license plates that are combinations of 17 no more than two series of special license plates authorized in this article and currently issued by the 18 Department; the fee for any such combination shall be equal to the sum of the fees for the two series 19 20 plus the fee for reserved numbers and letters, if applicable. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of 21 subsection B of this section shall not apply to special license plates that are combinations of two series 22 of special license plates authorized in this article and currently issued by the Department if one of the 23 two combined designs, when feasible, incorporates or includes the international symbol of access. 24 B. Except as otherwise provided in this article: 25 1. No license plates provided for in this article shall be issued until the Commissioner receives at least 350 prepaid applications therefor. In the event that 350 or more prepaid applications have not been 26 27 received on or before the last day of the third year from the date the license plates were last authorized, 28 no such license plates shall be issued unless the license plates are reauthorized by the General 29 Assembly. Such reauthorized license plates shall remain subject to the provisions of this article; 30 2. No additional license plates shall be issued or reissued in any series that, after five or more years 31 of issuance, has fewer than 100 active sets of plates, unless applications therefor again meet the criterion 32 of subdivision 1 of this subsection: and 33 3. The annual fee for the issuance of any license plates issued pursuant to this article shall be ten 34 dollars plus the prescribed fee for state license plates. Applications for all special license plates issued pursuant to this article shall be on forms prescribed by the Commissioner. All special license plates 35 36 issued pursuant to this article shall be of designs prescribed by the Commissioner and shall bear unique 37 letters and numerals, clearly distinguishable from any other license plate designs, and be readily 38 identifiable by law-enforcement personnel. 39 No other state license plates shall be required on any vehicles bearing special license plates issued 40 under the provisions of this article. All fees collected by the Department under this article shall be paid by the Commissioner into the 41 42 state treasury and shall be set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the expenses of the 43 Department. 44 C. The provisions of this article relating to registration fees shall apply only to those vehicles 45 registered as passenger cars, motor homes, and pick-up or panel trucks, as defined in § 46.2-100. All 46 other vehicle types registered with special license plates shall be subject to the appropriate special 47 license plate fees, registration fees and other fees prescribed by law for such vehicle types. 48 D. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision B.1., those special license plates authorized by the 49 General Assembly for current or former members of current or former military combat units that have at least 50 but fewer than 350 members may apply directly to the Department for issuance of special 50 51 license plates for current or former members of such units. Except as otherwise provided in this 52 subsection, applications for such special license plates shall be subject to the requirements for the 53 issuance of special license plates prescribed by this article and regulations of the Department. In addition to the prescribed registration fee, special license plates issued pursuant to this subsection shall 54 55 be subject to (i) the ten-dollar annual fee prescribed in subdivision B. 3. and (ii) an additional one-time 56 fee of ten dollars.
