9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 23-215 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 23-215. Responsibilities of Board and System.
12	A. The State Board for Community Colleges heretofore established by law is continued. The Board
13	shall be a corporation under the style of "the State Board for Community Colleges." The State Board
14	shall be responsible, through the exercise of the powers and performance of the duties set forth in this
15	chapter, for the establishment, control, and administration of a statewide system of publicly supported
16	comprehensive community colleges which shall be known as the Virginia Community College System.
17	B. The Virginia Community College System shall be the state agency with primary responsibility for
18	coordinating workforce training at the postsecondary to the associate degree level, exclusive of the
19	career and technical education programs provided through and administered by the public school system.
20	This responsibility shall not preclude other agencies from also providing such services as appropriate,
21	but these activities shall be coordinated with the community colleges.
22	C. In addition to other responsibilities of the Virginia Community College System, the community
23	colleges shall (i) offer non-credit courses at a time and place that meet the needs of employers and at a
24	cost not to exceed the incremental cost of each course, and (ii) deal directly with employers in
25	designing and offering courses to meet real, current and projected workforce training needs. For
26	purposes of this section, incremental cost is the addition to total cost that is incurred as a result of the

27 course. The procedures for determining incremental costs shall be promulgated by the Auditor of Public
28 Accounts and shall be used by each community college in carrying out the provisions of this subsection.

29 The community colleges shall report annually to the General Assembly on actions taken to meet the

30 requirements of this subsection.
