6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 60.2-602 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 60.2-602. Weekly benefit amount.

9 A. Beginning ~~November 28, 1999~~ September 9, 2001, and expiring January 1, 2003, for claims filed
10 on or after ~~November 28, 1999~~ September 9, 2001, and for claims for which a claimant had established
11 a benefit year as of September 9, 2001, an eligible individual's weekly "benefit amount" shall be the
12 amount appearing in Column B in the "Benefit Table" in this section on the line on which in Column A
13 of such table, there appears the total wages for insured work paid to such individual in the two quarters
14 of his base period in which such total wages were highest.

15 For claims filed prior to November 28, 1999, an eligible individual's weekly "benefit amount" shall
16 be computed under the provisions of this section in force on the date such claim was filed.

18 *B. Beginning January 1, 2003, for claims effective on or after January 1, 2003, but before January*
19 *1, 2004, an eligible individual's weekly "benefit amount" shall be the amount appearing in Column B in*
20 *the "Benefit Table" in this section on the line on which in Column A of such table, there appears the*
21 *total wages for insured work paid to such individual in the two quarters of his base period in which*
22 *such total wages were highest.*

23 C. Beginning January 1, 2004, for claims effective on or after January 1, 2004, an eligible
24 individual's weekly "benefit amount" shall be the amount appearing in Column B in the "Benefit Table"
25 in this section on the line on which in Column A of such table, there appears the total wages for
26 insured work paid to such individual in the two quarters of his base period in which such total wages
27 were highest.
