3	A BILL to amend and reenact § 15.2-961 of the Code of Virginia, relating to local tree canopy bank
4	ordinances.

9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 15.2-961 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 15.2-961. Replacement of trees during development process in certain localities.
12	A. Any locality with a population density of at least seventy-five persons per square mile may adopt
13 14	an ordinance providing for the planting and replacement of trees during the development process pursuant to the provisions of this section. Population density shall be based upon the latest population
15	estimates of the Cooper Center for Public Service of the University of Virginia.
16	B. The ordinance shall require that the site plan for any subdivision or development include the
17	planting or replacement of trees on the site to the extent that, at twenty years, minimum tree canopies or
18	covers will be provided in areas to be designated in the ordinance, as follows:
19 20	1. Ten percent tree canopy for a site zoned business, commercial, or industrial;
20 21	 Ten percent tree canopy for a residential site zoned twenty or more units per acre; Fifteen percent tree canopy for a residential site zoned more than ten but less than twenty units
22	per acre; and
23	4. Twenty percent tree canopy for a residential site zoned ten units or less per acre.
24	However, any city that was established prior to 1780 may require at ten years the minimum tree
25	canopies or covers set out above.
26 27	The ordinance shall provide for reasonable exceptions to or deviations from these requirements to allow for the reasonable development of farm land or other areas devoid of woody materials, for the
28	preservation of wetlands, or otherwise when the strict application of the requirements would result in
29	unnecessary or unreasonable hardship to the developer. In such instances, the [city of Manassas
30	ordinance] may [by ordinance] provide for a tree canopy bank whereby a portion of a development's
31	tree canopy requirement may be met from off-site at the direction of the [city council locality]. The
32 33	following shall be exempt from the requirements of any tree replacement or planting ordinance promulgated under this section: dedicated school sites, playing fields and other nonwooded recreation
34	areas, and other facilities and uses of a similar nature.
35	For purposes of this section:
36	"Tree canopy" or "tree cover" includes all areas of coverage by plant material exceeding five feet in
37	height, and the extent of canopy at maturity shall be based on published reference texts generally
38 39	accepted by landscape architects, nurserymen, and arborists in the community, and the texts shall be specified in the ordinance.
40	The ordinance may designate or provide a system for rating the desirability for planting of various
41	tree species. All trees to be planted shall meet the specifications of the American Association of
42	Nurserymen. The planting of trees shall be done in accordance with either the standardized landscape
43	specifications jointly adopted by the Virginia Nurserymen's Association, the Virginia Society of
44 45	Landscape Designers and the Virginia Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects, or the road and bridge specifications of the Virginia Department of Transportation.
46	Existing trees which are to be preserved may be included to meet all or part of the canopy
47	requirements, and may include wooded preserves, if the site plan identifies such trees and the trees meet
48	standards of desirability and life-year expectancy which the locality may establish.
49 50	C. Penalties for violations of ordinances adopted pursuant to this section shall be the same as those
50 51	applicable to violations of zoning ordinances of the locality. D. In no event shall any local tree replacement or planting ordinance adopted pursuant to this section
51 52	exceed the requirements set forth herein.
53	E. Nothing in this section shall be construed to invalidate any local ordinance adopted pursuant to
54	the provisions of this section prior to July 1, 1990, which imposes standards for tree replacement or
55	planting during the development process.
