| 16 | important to the efficient functioning of the nation's legal system, be recognized for their dedication to |

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby designate the Wednesday of the second full week of October, in 2002 and in each succeeding year, as Legal Professionals' Day in Virginia; and, be it
