 7 causing great destruction and horrible human suffering in New York, Virginia, and Pennsylvania; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the attack had a devastating effect in Virginia, home of the Pentagon and of many of 9 the personnel, military and civilian, who served there; and
- 10 WHEREAS, among the victims of the Pentagon attack was Norma Khan of Reston, a passenger on11 American Airlines Flight 77, which crashed into the Pentagon on September 11; and
- WHEREAS, the manager of member services for the Plumbing-Heating-Cooling Contractors National
 Association, Norma Khan was on her way to a conference in Los Angeles; and
- WHEREAS, Norma Khan was a single mother with a 13-year old son, Imran Khan, an eighth-grade
 student at Langston Hughes Middle School; now, therefore, be it
- 16 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
 17 note with great sadness the loss of Norma Khan, an innocent victim of the September 11 terrorist
 18 attacks on the United States; and, be it
- 19 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for
 20 presentation to the family of Norma Khan as an expression of the heartfelt condolences of the General
 21 Assembly of Virginia.
