WHEREAS, among the victims of the Pentagon attack was Captain Jack D. Punches, Jr., of Clifton, a retired Navy captain and deputy head of the Navy's interagency support branch at the Pentagon; and

WHEREAS, a native of Illinois, Captain Punches earned his bachelor's degree from Missouri
University and earned degrees in strategic studies from the Naval War College and in international
relations from Salve Regina University, both in Newport, Rhode Island; and

WHEREAS, designated a naval aviator in 1975, Captain Punches was assigned to the Jacksonville,
 Florida, Naval Air Station and was an executive officer of the Lifting Eagles in the fleet-logistics
 support squadron in Sigonella, Sicily; and
