9	as a research entomologist with the Systematic Entomology Lab in Beltsville, Maryland; and
10	WHEREAS, a widely published entomologist, Richard Foote was an authority on the Mediterranean
11	fruit fly and was the author of more than 160 publications, including the <u>Handbook of Fruit Flies of</u>
12	America North of Mexico; and
13	WHEREAS, Richard Foote was a former president of the Entomological Society of Washington and
14	the Washington Academy of Sciences and was a member of the Entomological Society of America; and
15	WHEREAS, a man of great talent and considerable professional achievement, Richard Foote will be
16	missed by his family, the Lake of the Woods community, and the American scientific community; now,
17	therefore, be it
