WHEREAS, the Reverend Dr. William Bernard Schiele of Hampton, the pastor of First Baptist 7 Church Jefferson Park for 41 years, died on February 20, 2002; and

WHEREAS, a native of Gilbert, Louisiana, Dr. Schiele graduated from Sevier Rosewald High School 8 and earned his bachelor's degree in theology from the American Baptist Theological Seminary in 9 10 Nashville, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Schiele, who continued his education at Virginia Union University, became pastor 11 12 of First Baptist Church Jefferson Park on February 1, 1956, and served with great devotion, vision, and leadership until his retirement in 1997; and 13

WHEREAS, under the strong leadership of Dr. Schiele, First Baptist Church Jefferson Park grew and 14 prospered, purchasing the property on which the current church is built, building the present church, 15 which was completed in 1967, and burning the mortgage on the church in 1974; and 16

WHEREAS, Dr. Schiele also oversaw the building of the church's Education Building in 1981, the 17 18 mortgage on which was also paid off in 1998; and

WHEREAS, the expansion of First Baptist Church Jefferson Park is reflected in the increased 19 20 numbers of deacons, trustees, and other officials, all of whom were the responsibility of Dr. Schiele and 21 all of whom he inspired and mentored; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Schiele led the formation of many new organizations and the reorganization of 23 others at First Baptist Church Jefferson Park, including the Church Interest Group, the Men's Club and 24 Male Chorus, the Floral Committee, the W. B. Schiele Gospel Chorus, and the Fellowship Committee; 25 and

26 WHEREAS, many other improvements to the church took place during the tenure of Dr. Schiele, whose influence on the lives of the parishioners of First Baptist Church Jefferson Park is profound, 28 treasured, and lasting; now, therefore, be it

29 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly note with great sadness the passing of one of Hampton's most prominent spiritual leaders, the Reverend Dr. 30 31 William Bernard Schiele; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for 32 33 presentation to the family of the Reverend Dr. William Bernard Schiele as an expression of the esteem 34 in which his memory is held by the members of the General Assembly.
