Allow the Governor to waive state statutory mandates and regulations to expedite the construction, reconstruction, alteration, or relocation of highways, bridges, tunnels, and associated facilities or structures whenever necessary to avert or respond to a natural disaster or an act of terrorism, or contribute to military operations during a time of war or state of emergency, to the maximum extent not inconsistent with federal law.
