4. **Title** Criminal history record information; foster care

5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill requires local boards and licensed child -placing agencies to obtain criminal history checks on any individual with whom the local board or agency is considering placing a child on an emergency, temporary or permanent basis. This bill also provides that criminal checks **may** be conducted on all adult household members residing in the home of the individual with whom the child is to be placed. The records checks are to be provided at no cost to the individual. In emergency circumstances, local boards and licensed child -placing agencies may obtain, from a criminal justice agency, the criminal record checks from the Central Criminal Records Exchange (CCRE) required by this bill via the Virginia Criminal Information Network (VCIN).
