Summary/Purpose: The billamends sections of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginiar elated to the duties and respon sibilities of the Board of Health (BOH) by assigning to the Board the functions of the Virginia Health Planning Board (VHPB). The bill provides permissive authority to BOH indeveloping a state health plan and conducting such studies of critical health is sues, a sit deems necessary. The bill also stipulates that the regional health planning agencies in existence as of July 1,2002 would remain the designate dagencies unless the BOH revises those designations through regulation. In addition, regulations promulgated by the VHPB prior to July 1,2002 would remain inforce until amended, modified, or repealed. Other amendments are technical in nature. The bill amends and reenacts section 32.1 - 13.1 32.1-122.01 and 32.1 - 122.03 through 32.1 - 122.08 and repeal section 32.1 - 122.02 of the Code eliminating the VHPB.
