5. Summary/Purpose:ThisbilldirectstheSuperintendentofPublicIns truction,inpreparing and submitting estimates for budgetary purposes relative to the Basic School Aid Formulato each school division and to the local governing body of each county, city and town that operates as eparates chool division, to enumerate all statefunding to be received by the school division, whether from basic aid or other state programs, and include a perpupilamount based on the projected averaged ailymembership for the relevant school division for the coming fiscal year.

- 8. Fiscalimplications:Currently,theSuperintendentofPublicInstructionshall,nolaterthan the15 thdayfollowingfinaladjournmentoftheGeneralAssembly,submitestimatestobe usedforbudgetarypurposesrelativetotheBasicSchoolAidFormulatoeachschooldivision andtothelocalgoverningbodyofeachcounty,cityandtownthatoperatesaseparateschool division.Suchestimatesshallbeforeachyearofthenextbienniumor forthenextfiscal year.

Thisbillwouldrequirethattheestimatesenumerateallstatefundingtobereceivedbythe schooldivision, whether basicaid or other state programs, and include aperpupilamount based on the projected averaged ailymember ship (ADM) for the relevant schooldivision for the coming fiscal year. Within 10 days of providing such estimate, the Superintendent shall publish, for three consecutive days in an ewspaper of general circulation within each such school division, acompletel is ting of such estimates and perpupilamounts for all school divisions in the Common wealth and shall provide this list to each school division.

Currently, the Department of Education uses the Superintendent's memoprocess to communicate changes inf unding to local school divisions. As part of this process, the department posts state entitlement information on its website in both PDF form and in Excel. Through the Excel program, localities are able to revise ADM to runvarious state funding scenarios. This information is posted when the Governor's introduced budget is released, when the House and Senate produce budget reports in mid -session, and when a final budget is authorized by the General Assembly. For example, in December 2001, state entitlem ent informationwasprovidedtoschooldivisionsforfiscalyear2002,fiscalyear2003,andfiscal year2004thatcorrelatedtothefiguresincludedintheGovernor'sIntroducedBudget.

The department would now be required to publish this information in mewspapers. The cost for publishing would depend upon the size of the advertisement and the newspapers chosen to publish the data and the amount of departments taff time required to prepare the materials for publication. Although it is difficult to quant if y, the costs to the state could be substantial given the number of papers in which the data would need to be published and the length of time required for publishing.
