5. Summary/Purpose:Thisbillclarifiesthatwhenperiodic weekly,monthly,quarterly,orlump sumworkers' compensationbenefitpaymentsaremadetoasurvivingspouseforeitherhis benefitorthebenefitofminorchildren,thatspouseisempoweredtoreceiveandgivereceiptfor suchpaymentstothesameextent asacourt -appointedguardianadlitem.Thissurviving spouse'sacknowledgementofreceiptshallfullydischargeallclaimsordemandseitherthe spouseorhisminorchildrencouldlodgeagainstthedeceasedemployee'semployer.Inaddition, thelegisla tionpermitstheVirginiaWorkers'CompensationCommissiontorequireannual writtencertificationsfromthesurvivingspouseconfirmingthatanypaymentmadeforthebenefit oftheirminorchildrenhasbeenusedforthebenefitofthatminorchil dorthoseminor children.Thislegislationincludesanemergencyclause.

Fiscalimplications:None.Thislegislationisdesignedtoaddresscertainissuesthathave arisenfromthepa ymentofworkers' compensation benefits by the Common wealth to the survivingspousesandchildrenoftheNationalGuardsmenkilledinthelineofdutyduringa trainingmissionlastyear. Although the Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission was responsible for issuing the award amounts, local courts we reresponsible for ensuring that the benefitspaidtothesesurvivingspouses' minorchildrenwereusedforthebenefitofthose minorchildren.Consequently,somelocalcourtsrequiredtheappointmentof guardiansad litemtooverseetheseminorchildren'sbenefitswhileothersdidnot, somelocal courts required these guardians additent to be bonded while others did not, and some local courts strictlydefinedhowminorchildren'sbenefitscouldbeusedwh ileothersdidnot. Consequently, an eedarose for some level of uniformity. This legislation would provide that levelofuniformitybyempoweringtheVirginiaWorkers'CompensationCommissionto overseetheseworkers' compensation claims from beginning toend.However,this legislationdoesnotaffectthetotalworkers' compensation payments made by the CommonwealthorincreasetheoperatingcostsoftheVirginiaWorkers'Compensation Commission.
