Summary/Purpose: The bill directs the Virginia Waste Management Board to establish a new permit feesch edule sufficient to cover no more than 20 percent of the direct cost of the hazardous and solid waste management programs based on allocations made to these programs in the 2002 Appropriation Act; however, no individual permit fee may increase more than 30 Opercent of the fee in existence on July 1, 2002. The bill also triples the statutory caps on the amounts the State Water Control Board can charge for its various water permits. The provisions of the bill would expire on July 1, 2004.
