Summary/Purpose: Thislegislationwould exemptfromtheVirginialicensureor certificationrequirementsoftheBoardforOpticiansandtheBoardsofDentistry,Medicine, Nursing, Optometry, Pharmacy, and Veterinary Medicine certain out -of-statepractitioners Virginia,(ii)holdcurrentvalidlicensesorcertificatesto who(i)donotregularlypracticein practiceinanotherstate, territory, districtor possession of the United States, (iii) volunteer to providefreehealthcaretoanunderservedareaofthisCommonwealthundertheauspicesof a publiclysupported all volunteer, nonprofitor ganization with no paid employees that sponsors the provision of health care to populations of under served people throughout the world, (iv) filecopiesofthelicensesorcertificatesissuedinsuchotherju risdictionwiththeappropriate board, and (v) notify the appropriate board, within fifteen days prior to the voluntary provisionofservices of the dates and location of such services. Enactment clauses require emergencyregulationsandauthorizethevar iousboardstorequirethesponsoring organizationtoregisterandpayafeepriortodeliveringservicesinVirginia.

Thislegislationwasamendedtolimitamountoftimeandlocationofpracticeforallofthe specifiedpractitioners.Inaddition,l anguagewasaddedtoallowboardstodisallowpractice, exceptforBoardfroOpticians,ifanindividualisfoundtobeinviolationofapplicablelaws orregulations.

Fiscalimplications: AlthoughtheDepartmentofHealthProfessions(DHP)cannotprovide anestimateastothenumberofpractitionersthatwouldregistertopracticeinavolunteer capacity,theagencydoesnotexpectasignificantfiscalimpact.Inaddition,tothesmall expenseassociatedwithadditionalregistrations,itwillcostapproximately\$5,000inthefirst yeartopromulgatetheemergencyregulationsrequiredbythislegislation.Thesecostsare associatedwiththerule -makingprocessandincludeexpensesforcom mitteemeetings,public hearings,andmailings.
