3. Committee Agriculture, Conservation & Natural Resources

4. Title Animal abandonment or dumping; penalties.

5. Summary/Purpose: Adds definition of animal "dumping" to animal welfare laws. To "dump" means to abandon any dog, cat or other domesticated animal in any public place including the right-of-way of any public highway, road or street or on the property of another. The penalty for animal abandonment or dumping is decreased from a Class 2 to a Class 3 misdemeanor.

6. No Fiscal Impact: See Item 8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The proposed legislation would not result in an increase in persons confined in jails since a Class 3 misdemeanor conviction does not carry a sentence of incarceration. There could be additional revenue from fines being assessed due to this legislation but such increases are not feasible to project.
