- **7. Budgetamendmentnecessary:** Potentiallyifongoingfederalfundingforterrorismrelated duties does not materialize.
- 8. Fiscalimplications: Asmentionedabove, newduties such as those required by this legislation would likely be incorporated into a new classified position. The use of a contractor or temporary employee is not aviable opt ion given the sensitively of the data that would be maintained. The costs listed in item 6 include personal service costs for a statistical analyst with database experience (estimated at \$32,000 plus fringe benefit costs for a total cost of \$38,133 in FY 2003 (assuming 22 payperiods) and \$41,600 in FY 2004). Annual support costs of \$4,500 are also included in each year (\$3,000 per year for office supplies and telecommunications; \$1,000 for travel and/or other costs specific to assuring laboratory compliance; \$500 for overhead charges such as spacerental, statelia bility in surance and databases of tware licensing). One -time expenses of \$3,000 are included in the first year only for the purchase of necessary of fice and computer equipment.
