- **8. Fiscalimplications:** This legislation would not have a significant adverse impact on agency operationsifnofunding(i.e.federalorgeneralfunddollars)wereavailable.However,to fullyimplementthebill'sintent,theVirginiaDepartmentofHealth(VDH)wouldrequire someadditionalresources(fundinganda classifiedposition.)Th euseofacontractoror temporaryemployeeisnotaviableoptiongiventhecomplexityandsensitivelyofthedata thatwouldbemaintained. The personal service costs for a statistical analyst with database experienceisestimatedat\$32,000plusfringe benefitcostsforatotalcostof\$38,133inFY 2003(assuming22payperiods)and\$41,600inFY2004.Annualsupportcostsof\$4,500 would also be required in each year (\$3,000 per year for office supplies and telecommunications; \$1,000 for traveland/o rother costs specific to assuring laboratory compliance;\$500foroverheadchargessuchasspacerental,stateliabilityinsuranceand databasesoftwarelicensing). Aone -timeexpense of \$3,000 would be needed in the first year onlyforthepurchaseofn ecessaryofficeandcomputerequipment.

Althoughlikely, it is uncertain at this time to what extent the federal government will provide on going funding for staff to meet new domestic terror is mrelated duties in the Virginia Department of Health and othe restate public health agencies. The reporting requirements proposed by this legislation would most likely be incorporated into a single position's duties along with other new bioterror is mrelated responsibilities. Again, if no additional nongeneral fund (federal) support were available, the agency would not be able to completely implement this legislation without general fund dollars.
