5. Summary/Purpose: Thisbillwouldrequirel aboratoriesintheCommonwealthtoreporttheir inventoriesandchangesofinventoriesofdangerousmicrobesandpathogenstotheVirginia DepartmentofHealth.Thelaboratoriesmustalsoimmediatelyreportinventorythatcannotbe accountedforwithin24 hours.TheBoardofHealthshalldeterminethelistofdangerous microbesandpathogenstobereportedandthemannerofsuchreporting.Thebillwas amendedtoexcludethelaboratoryreportsfromtheFreedomofInformationActandestablish penalties(per§32.1 -27)fortheunauthorizeddisclosure.

*Itisuncertainatthistimetowha textentthefederalgovernmentwillprovideongoingfundingforstafftomeet newdomesticterrorismrelateddutiesintheVirginiaDepartmentofHealthandotherstatepublichealth agencies.Thereportingrequirementsproposedbythislegislationwould mostlikelybeincorporatedintoasingle position'sdutiesalongwithothernewbioterrorismrelatedresponsibilities.

8. Fiscalimplications: Thislegislationwouldnothaveasignificantadverseimp actonagency operationsifnofunding(i.e.federalorgeneralfunddollars)wereavailable.However,to fullyimplementthebill'sintent, the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) would require someadditionalresources(fundinganda classifiedposition.)Theuseofacontractoror temporaryemployeeisnotaviableoptiongiventhecomplexityandsensitivelyofthedata thatwouldbemaintained. The personal service costs for a statistical analyst with database experienceisestimatedat\$32,000plus fringebenefitcostsforatotalcostof\$38,133inFY 2003(assuming22payperiods)and\$41,600inFY2004.Annualsupportcostsof\$4,500 would also be required in each year (\$3,000 per year for office supplies and telecommunications; \$1,000 for travel and/or other costs specific to assuring laboratory compliance;\$500foroverheadchargessuchasspacerental,stateliabilityinsuranceand databasesoftwarelicensing). Aone -timeexpenseof\$3,000wouldbeneededinthefirstyear onlyforthepurchas eofnecessaryofficeandcomputerequipment.

Althoughlikely, it is uncertain at this time to what extent the federal government will provide ongoing funding forst aff to meet new domestic terrorism related duties in the Virginia Department of Healthan dotherst at epublic health agencies. The reporting requirements proposed by this legislation would most likely be incorporated into a single position's duties along with other new bioterrorism related responsibilities. Again, if no additional nongeneral fund (federal) support we reavailable, the agency would not be able to completely implement this legislation without general fund dollars.
