5. **Summary/Purpose:** The bill would allow municipalsolidwastelandfillsutilizingdouble synthetic liners systems that were permitted between December 21, 1988 and October 9, 1993 and that are part of an approved post-mining land use plan to continue to accept solid waste after 2020. Currently, municipalsolidwastelandfills may not continue to accept waste after 2020 in any disposal area not equipped with a liner system approved pursuant to a permit issued after October 9, 1993.
