HB254increasesthecivilpenaltyforal lviolationsofSec.46.2- 1095,whichrequirestheuse of childrestraint devices or safety belts ystems for children less than 16 years of age. This bill will raise the penalty of subsection Arequiring use of childrestraint devices for children under a ge4, by \$50, from \$50 to \$100. This bill will also raise the penalty of subsection B, requiring use of restraint devices for children 4 through 16, by \$75, from \$25 to \$100 and would attach court costs to subsection B where court costs are currently barr ed. Revenue generated by the increase infees will accrue to the Child Restraint Device Special Fund, a fund operated by the Department of Health "to promote, purchase and distribute childrestraint devices to applicants who... are unable to acquire one because of financial in a bility." Additional revenue from court costs will revert to the general fund.
