8.	Fiscalimplications: The fiscal implications of this legislation are uncertain. While there will likely be a fi scalimpact on DMV due to increase dpayments to automate dagents, it is difficult to acc urately estimate the amount of that impact. In FY2001, to talcollections by licensed agents were approximately \$16.9 million, with total payments of \$525,000 for an overall effective payment rate of 3.1%. Increasing this rate to 3.5% would result in approximately \$68,000 in additional payments. The department advises that it expects that increase to remain constant in future fiscal years as well.
