Costsforofficespacewouldalsoincludecomputerequipment,furnishings,etc.Atthistime,it appearsthatthedep artmentcouldabsorbthesecostswithintheirexistingbudget,butwouldhave toreducespendinginotherareastoaccommodatethisexpense.
