4. Title Sight-seeing carriers by boat and special or charter party carriers.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Sight-seeing carriers by boat and special or charter party carriers by boat.
Repeal the requirement that sight -seeing carriers by boat, special or charter party carriers by boat, and motor carriers by launch obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) before engaging in business on the waters within the Commonwealth, as well as the requirements that such carriers file and maintain tariffs and schedules with DMV.
