4. **Title** School board policies; student surveys.

5. **Summary/Purpose:** This bill requires local school boards to develop and implement policies to prohibit the administration of questionnaires or surveys to public school students during the regular school day or at school-sponsored events without written, informed parental consent for the student's participation in such questionnaire or survey when participation may subsequently result in the sale of personal information regarding the individual student.

6. **Fiscal Impact:** minimal (See 8.)

8. **Fiscal implications:** There could be some minimal costs to local school divisions related to the establishment of policies prohibiting the administration of questionnaires or surveys to public school students and administering the parent consent process.
