5. Summary/Purpose:

Thislegislationproposestoamend§46.2 -208oftheCodeofVirginiarelatingtothereleaseof informationcontainedintherecordsoftheDepartmentofMotor Vehicle(DMV). The legislationspecificallyprovidesthat, on the written request of any person who has applied to be avolunteer with a Virginia affiliate of Compeer, the DMV Commissioner will (i) compare personal information supplied by a Virginia affiliate of Compeer with that contained in the Department's records and, when the information supplied by a Virginia affiliate of Compeer with correctin for mation as contained in the Department's records and (ii) provide driver information (in the form of an abstract of the applicant's records how in gall convictions, accidents, license suspensions or revocations, and any type of driver's license that the individual currently possesses). This information will be provided free of charge.

- **8. Fiscalimplications:** The fiscal impact of this legislation is uncertain. Thisbillwould, after receivingwrittenauthorization,permitanaffiliateofCompeertoprovideDMVwith information for comparison with DMV records. Intheeventthattheinformationprovidedto DMVisdifferentfromthatcontainedinDMV'srecords,DMV wouldberequiredtoprovide the affiliate with corrected information and provide a driver record (showing all convictions, accidents, licenses uspensions/revocations and driver's licenses) of the would -bevolunteer. (Thisbillwouldcreateaprovisionv erysimilartotheprovisioncontainedinsubsectionB(13) of §46.2 - 208 pertaining to Big Brothers/Big Sisters of America. Compeerisanotforprofit organizationwhichmatchescommunityvolunteers in supportive friendship relationships with childrenan dadultsreceivingmentalhealthtreatmenttoshareactivitiessuchasmovies, sports, shopping, coffee and achat, or many of the free activities sponsored by the Compeer Program. Thereappears to be thousands of Compeer volunteers and responding to the s e requests could ultimately cost the DMV instaff time and materials. However, it is difficult to estimatethepotentialcostswithoutknowingthenumberofrequestsinanygivenyear.

The bill would impact Compeer primarily by ensuring that this inform at ion is provided free of charge and could potentially impact the safety of Compeer clients by ensuring that Compeer has information regarding the driving record of its volunteer applicants, prior to permitting the volunteer stotransport clients.
