- **5. Summary/Purpose:** Thislegislationproposestoamend§46.2 -208oftheCodeofVirginia relating to the release of information contained in the records of the Department of Motor Vehicle(DMV). The legislation specifically provides that, on the written request of any personwhohasappliedtobeavolunteerwithaVirginiaaffiliateofCompeer,theDMV Commissionerwill(i)comparepersonalinformationsuppliedbyaVirginiaaffiliat eof Compeerwiththat contained in the Department's records and, when the information supplied byaVirginiaaffiliateofCompeerisdifferentfromthatcontainedintheDepartment's records, providetheVirginiaaffiliateofCompeerwithcorrectinformat ionascontainedinthe Department's records and (ii) provided river information (in the form of an abstract of the applicant's records howing all convictions, accidents, licenses uspensions or revocations, and anytypeofdriver'slicensethattheindivid ualcurrentlypossesses). This information will be providedfreeofchargeiftherequestisaccompaniedbyappropriatewrittenevidencethatthe personhasappliedtobeavolunteerwithaVirginiaaffiliateofCompeer.

- **8. Fiscalimplications:** The fiscal impact of this legislation is uncertain. Thisbillwould, after receivingwrittenauthorization,permitanaffiliateofCompeertoprovideDMVwith information for comparison with DMV records.
