4. **Title** Notary public; duties.

5. **Summary/Purpose:**

Requires that the identity of each person subject of a notarial act be identified by passport, certificate of citizenship or naturalization, driver's license, state-issued identification card, or military identification card. Also provides that a notary shall maintain a record of specific information relative to each notarial act performed that will be subject to review and audit by the Secretary of the Commonwealth. Failure to comply with these requirements subjects a notary to removal from office.

8. **Fiscal implications:** The Secretary of the Commonwealth estimates this amendment represents no additional fiscal impact beyond that required by the current statute. This amendment's fiscal implications are applicable only to notaries themselves. Notary public will bear any costs related to recordation of each notarial act.
