Summary/Purpose: This legislation is proposing to amend § 46.2 -752 of the Code of Virginia to provide that where acounty, city, or town has entered into an agreement with the DMVC ommissioner where by the Commissioner will refuse to is sue or renewany vehicle registration of any applicant who owes the county, city or town certain fees or taxes, the applicable fees and taxes will be (i) the locality's vehicle license (decal) fee and (ii) tangible personal property taxes. Current provisions exempting delinquent personal property taxes of \$50 or less and requiring that the tax belevied against the vehicle whose registration is being denied are eliminated.
