## 5. Summary/Purpose:

Thepurposeofthislegislationistocreateapresumptionthathypertensionorotherheart diseaseresultinginthedeathorthetotalorpartialdisabilityofapoliceofficeremployedby theMetrop olitanWashingtonAirportsAuthorityisanoccupationaldisease,andis,therefore, aworkers' compensationeligibleevent.Similarpresumptionshavebeenestablishedinthe pastforfirefighters,policeofficers,sheriffs,sheriffs'deputies,marinepatr olofficers,full timegamewardens,andtheDepartmentofEmergencyManagement'shazardousmaterials officers.Anamendmentadoptedintheengrossedversionofthisbillrendersthisactineffect onlyforaslongastheMetropolitanWashingtonAirports Authorityvoluntarilywishesto subjectitselftoit.

- FiscalImpact:No.ThislegislationhasnofiscalimpactupontheCommonwealth.The MetropolitanWashingtonAirportsAuthorityisanindependententitycreatedbyChapter598, 1985ActsofAsse mbly,andtheDistrictofColumbiaRegionalAirportsAuthorityAct,passed byCongressin1985.
- 7. Budgetamendmentnecessary:No.
- 8. Fiscalimplications: Although there was very little publicly -availableinformationaboutthe numberofpoliceofficer semployedbytheMetropolitanWashingtonAirportsAuthorityorits currentworkers' compensation practices, apotential guide to the Authority's costs of complying with this legislation may be found in information collected by the Virginia Workers'Compen sationProgram, adivision of the Department of Human Resource Management, regarding the costs of serious hypertension -relatedhealtheventsreportedbythe DepartmentofStatePolice'stroopers.Accordingtothisinformation,theaveragecostofa serioushypertension -relatedhealtheventforaStatePolicetrooperis\$100,000.Inaddition, approximatelyonepercentofthatagency'sofficerswillmakehypertension -relatedworkers' compensationclaimseachyear. However, since the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authorityisonlyboundbytheseprovisionsforaslongasitsowishestobeboundbythem, thatentitycouldrejectthislegislation.Ifthisweretohappen,theAuthoritywouldexperience nofiscalimplicationsfromthisbill'spassage.
- 9. Specificagencyorpoliticalsubdivisionsaffected:ThisproposalaffectsonlytheMetropolitan Washington Airports Authority, which is an independent political entity separate from the Commonwealthoritspoliticalsub -divisions.
