The costs of implementing and operating the program are to be borne by the agency's Vehicle Emissions Inspection ProgramFund.ThebillalsorequirestheDepartmentofMotorVehiclestoreleasevehicle ownerdatatotheDepartmentofEnvironmentalQuality(uponitsrequest)inconnectionwith enforcementactionsinvolvingon -roadtestingofmotorvehicles.Thebillre quirestheState AirPollutionControlBoardtoestablishseparateanddistinctemissionsstandardsapplicable toon -roadtestingofmotorvehicles, with such criteria being applicable to all motorvehicles manufacturedforthe1968modelyearoranymore recentmodelyear, with criteria for each modelyearbeingappropriatetothatmodelyear.Inaddition,thebillincludesprovisionsfor theexpeditedidentification of "grossviolators" of motor vehicle emissions standards. The billalsowouldreducefro m90daysto15calendardaysthetimegiventoownersofvehicles foundbyon -roadtestingtobenotincompliancewithemissionsstandardstoeithershowthat thevehicleshavepassedasubsequentemissionsinspection, qualifyforwaivers, or have been givenwaivers.

Fiscalimplications: AccordingtotheDepartmentofEnvironmentalQuality,theagency wouldneedtwoadditionalpositionstoimplementthenewassistanceprogram.Thepositions wouldberesponsibleforevaluatingeligibilityandprocessin gpaymentsforrepairsubsidies. Theagencyestimatesthat\$285,000annuallycouldbemadeavailablefortheassistance program.Thisincludes\$100,000forsalariesandbenefitsforthetwoadditionalpositions, \$35,000forprogramsupportcosts(supplie s,equipment,printing,publicinformation,postage, etc.),and\$150,000forassistancepayments.

Therecould be additional costs to the Department of Motor Vehicles associated with the requirement that the agency release vehicle owner data to the Depart ment of Environmental Quality (upon its request) in connection with enforcement actions involving on -road testing of motor vehicles. However, DPB cannot estimate the amount of any such potential costs.
