- **4. Title** Motorvehicleemissionsinspections
- 5. Summary/Purpose: The bill requires the Department of Environmental Quality to operate a programtosubsidi zerepairsofvehiclesthatfailtomeetemissionsstandardswhentheowner ofthevehicleisfinanciallyunabletohavethevehiclerepaired. The costs of implementing and operating the program are to be borne by the agency's Vehicle Emissions Inspection ProgramFund. The billals or equires the Department of Motor Vehicles to release vehicle ownerdatatotheDepartmentofEnvironmentalQuality(uponitsrequest)inconnectionwith enforcementactionsinvolvingon -roadtestingofmotorvehicles. Thebil AirPollutionControlBoardtoestablishseparateanddistinctemissionsstandardsapplicable toon -roadtestingofmotorvehicles, with such criteria being applicable to all motorvehicles manufacturedforthe1968modelyearoranym orerecentmodelyear(exceptforanymotor vehicleregisteredasanantiquemotorvehicle), with criteria for each model year being appropriate to that modely ear. In addition, the billincludes provisions for the expedited identificationof"grossviola tors"ofmotorvehicleemissionsstandards. Thebillalsowould reducefrom90daysto30calendardaysthetimegiventoownersofvehiclesfoundbyon roadtestingtonotbeincompliancewithemissionsstandardstoeithershowthatthevehicles havepa ssedasubsequentemissionsinspection, qualify forwaivers, or have been given waivers.

7. Budgetamendmentnecessary: Theconfereesincludedalanguageamendmentauthorizing theDepartmentofEnvi ronmentalQualitytouseupto\$300,000eachyearfromtheVehicle EmissionsInspectionFundtoimplementtheprovisionofthisbill.TheDepartmentof PlanningandBudgetcanprovidethenecessaryappropriationadministratively.

8. Fiscalimplications: According to the Department of Environmental Quality, the agency would need two additional positions to implement the new assistance program. The positions would be responsible for evaluating eligibility and processing payments for repair subsidies. The agency estimates that \$285,000 annually could be made available for the assistance program. This includes \$100,000 for salaries and benefits for the two additional positions, \$35,000 for program support costs (supplies, equipment, printing, public information, postage, etc.), and \$150,000 for assistance payments.

TherecouldbeadditionalcoststotheDepartmentofMotorVehiclesassociatedwiththe requirementthattheagencyreleasevehicleownerdatatotheD epartmentofEnvironmental Quality(uponitsrequest)inconnectionwithenforcementactionsinvolvingon -roadtestingof motorvehicles.However,DPBcannotestimatetheamountofanysuchpotentialcosts.
