8. Fiscalimplications: According to the Department of Environmental Quality, the agency would need two additional positions to implement the new assistance program. The positions would be responsible for evaluating eligibility and process in gpayments for repair subsidies. The agency estimates that \$285,000 annually could be made available for the assistance program. This includes \$100,000 for salaries and benefits for the two additional positions, \$35,000 for program support costs (supplie s, equipment, printing, public information, postage, etc.), and \$150,000 for assistance payments.
