5. Summary/Purpose:Thebill removes these as ideexemption from the requirement to have a saltwater fishing license when fishing intidal waters. The bill expands the saltwater fishing exemption to include aperson fishing from property he owns or rents, or his non paying guest or immediate family, from having to obtain a saltwater recreational fishing license. Currently, the exemption is limited to the person who owns property or his non paying guest or immediate family member. Persons fishing from a federal park or reserve located on the Eastern shore would also be exempted from having to obtain a license.

Fiscalimplications: The Marine Resources Commission estimates tha tremoving the exemption for seaside fishing from the requirements for a saltwater recreational fishing license will result in a revenue increase of \$70,000 for the Saltwater Recreational Fishing Development Fund (an additional 10,000 licenses sold with net revenue of \$7 per license). The other changes to the licensing requirements in the bill will have a minimal fiscal impact.
