Existingstatutealsorequirestheapplicanttopaythescreeningassessmentcostunlessthe hiringentitydecidestopayit.Withthisbill,itispossibletherewillbeadditionalapplicants forwhichthescreeningassessmentwouldb eneeded.Therewillbenoincreaseinscreening assessmentcostsasthesearebornebytheapplicant.
