- **8. Fiscalimplications:** While it is not clear exactly how much this proposal would cost each institution of higher education, it is clear that such are quirement for SOL testing for certain under graduates would require the institution stopurch as ethe appropriate number of tests and

provide for the administration and grading of the tests. For institutions with a large number of affected students, the costs could be substantial.

Additionally, SCHEV and DOE would be required to notify all students who would be required to take the tests under this legislation develop and distribute to all such freshman under graduate students Standards of Learning study guides designed to facilitate the study of the relevant curricula. Such requirements would require expenditures for printing and postage to notify students of this requirement as well as the development and printing of study guides.

Currentlythereareapproximately 12,000 students attending Virginia's public colleges and universities who are from either out of-statest udents or who did NO T graduate from a Virginia public high school.
