4. Title Fire Services Grant Program; expenditure of funds.

5. Summary/Purpose:

This legislation seeks to amend §38.2 -401 of the Code of Virginia to allow the funds allocated from the Fire Programs Fund to the Fire Services Grant Program and the Dry Hydrant Grant Program to be used as grants to provide regional fire service training facilities, to finance the Virginia Fire Incident Reporting System and to build or repair burn buildings, and for no other purpose.

7. Budget amendment necessary: None.

8. Fiscal implications: This legislation has no fiscal impact on the Department of Fire Programs. The legislation is seeking to add language §38.2 -401.D. that states that these funds can be used for no other purposes. However, paragraph E. states that "Money on the Fund shall not be diverted or expended for any purpose not authorized by this section."
